On October 19, 2011 the Citizens Advisory Council's Air Committee discussed three rulemakings with Bureau of Air Quality staff:

- Final-omitted rulemaking repealing the employer trip reduction regulation;
- Final-omitted rulemaking repealing the portable fuel containers regulation;
- Final-omitted rulemaking repealing the alternative sulfur dioxide emission standard for St. Joe Resources in Beaver County.

On the recommendation of the Air Committee, on November 15, the Citizens Advisory Council voted to concur with proceeding to the Environmental Quality Board with the rulemakings.
